1. VENUE

Racing will take place on the water off of Port Dalhousie Yacht Club. Course location will be available in the sailing instructions.

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012, and the rules of the Kirby 25 Class Association, except as any of these are modified by the Notice of Race, and the Sailing instructions (and any amendments thereto).

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. The regatta is open to all boats Kirby 25 Class members. Eligibility requirements are as follows: boats must meet all ownership, class membership and class measurement requirements and have paid all event fees.

2.2. Eligible boats may enter by registering prior to 0900 June 5th, 2010 at the DYC registration table.

3. FEES

3.1. Required Fees are as follows:

\$40 per Boat

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Dates of racing: June 5th 1100 First Gun, June 6th 1000 First Gun

4.2. Skippers Meeting will be held on June 5th 0930

4.3. Launch and Haulout. Boats must be launched on Saturday June 5th by 1000. Haulout will commence immediately following racing on Sunday June 6th with priority to out of town boats. Boats will be launched and hauled free of charge at DYC (within accordance to the safety limits of the clubs fixed crane). If you need to make alternate arrangements please contact the Regatta Committee.

4.4. Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible following the last Race on Sunday.

5. MEASUREMENTS

Each boat will abide by their Class measurement rules. No provisions have been made for measurement at the event.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The race committee will establish courses, which will require approximately 60 minutes for the first boat to finish. The sailing instructions will be available on the DYC website by June 28th, 2010. Printed copies will be available during registration.

7. SCORING

The low-point scoring system, rule A4 shall apply, and is modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with no scores discarded.

8. BERTHING

DYC will attempt to assign docks where feasible. Rafting off of the wall in front of the club house may be required. Directions will be provided at launch or upon arrival in the channel.

9. HAULOUT RESTRICTIONS

Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Regatta Committee.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall not make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats in each fleet unless otherwise negotiated with the Regatta Committee.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party general liability insurance, in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.
